Graduated in Biological Sciences in 2016 at the Polytechnic University of Marche, obtained a Master Degree in Marine Sciences at the University of Genova in 2019. Currently is PhD student in the Doctorate program 'Life and Environment' at the University of Trieste (Tutor: Dr. Stanislao Bevilacqua). Since the beginning of her studies, she was interested in marine biology and ecology. Over the years she developed a particular interest in the conservation and the sustainable management of the marine environment and resources.

Research

Her PhD project is focused on the assessment of the natural capital stored in the rocky intertidal reef habitats, with a particular interest in the *Cystoseira* forests, which are essential for the health and the functioning of the marine environment. The goal of the PhD project is to provide an adequate evaluation of the natural resources associated to marine benthic ecosystem in order to preserve the marine environment and to reach a sustainable development. In addition, she will evaluate the correlation between biodiversity and the functioning of the ecosystem in order to quantify the consequences of the loss of species due to anthropogenic activities.
